The SLO Vocal Arts ensemble under the direction of Gary Lamprecht, is pleased to offer one scholarship of \$1000 to a graduating high school senior in SLO county.

This scholarship will be awarded to an orchestral string player or vocalist.

The scholarship is offered in honor of our founding director, Gary Lamprecht, and his wife, Patricia. The Lamprechts are lifelong musicians who have shared their gifts with audiences for decades. Gary Lamprecht taught choral music for San Luis Coastal from 1973 to 2006, creating one of the finest choral programs in California. His choirs collected many Superior and Command Performance Awards in festivals. Mr. Lamprecht was the first Teacher of the Year for his district as well as the SLO County Teacher of the Year and a California State Mentor Teacher. He received the American Choral Directors Association Howard Swan Award for lifetime achievement in choral direction.

Pat is both a vocalist and instrumentalist and has played viola with the SLO Symphony and Orchestra Novo. She sings alto with the Vocal Arts Ensemble, currently in its 40th year.

To honor them, the Vocal Arts Ensemble has endowed this scholarship.
